The State Fire Administrator has activated the State Fire Mutual Aid Plan to support wildfires downstate. OFPC has requested resource availability for a possible deployment to affected counties. Resources requested for deployment will be notified no later than 11/15/2024 at 1300. The duration of the deployment is expected to be up to 72 hours.

Equipment requested:

Engine Type I or II

- A Type I must include a minimum of 1,000 GPM pump, 400 gallons of onboard water, 1,200' (2.5") hose, 400' (1.5") hose, 200' (1") hose, and 4 SCBA-qualified firefighters.
- Type II must include a minimum of 500 GPM pump, 400 gallons of onboard water, 1,000' (2.5") hose, 500' (1.5") hose, 300' (1") hose, and 3 SCBA-qualified firefighters.

Tender (tanker) Type I

 \cdot A Type I must include a minimum of 300 GPM pump, 2,000 gallons of onboard water, and three firefighters able to fill and dump water.

UTV/ATV

Hand Crews

· Five firefighters with current physical and brush firefighting equipment.

All equipment, including hand crew and UTV/ATV transportation, must be department-owned. A way to fuel equipment on the way to and from the deployment location is also required (Card). After arriving at the check-in location, fuel will be provided. Personnel must bring food, water, and personal supplies for the 72 hours.

This is not an order to deploy. This is only a request for availability. Without a deployment order, no equipment will leave the county for this purpose.
